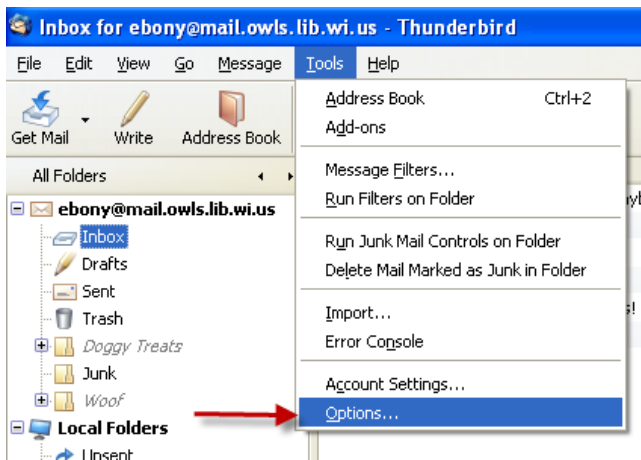


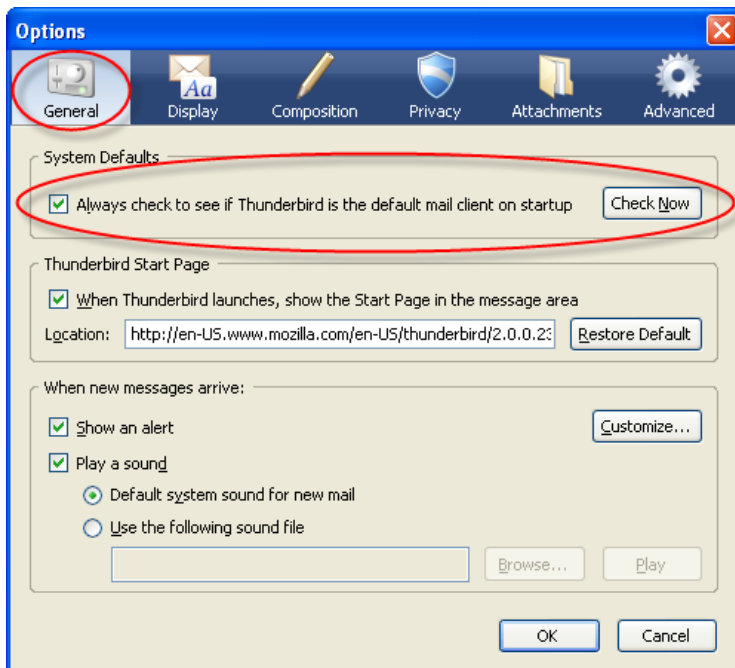
Configure Thunderbird As Your Default Email Client

Many Windows applications include a “Send To / Mail Recipient” option in the File drop down menu. This option automatically opens an email compose window (containing your document) using your default email client. Unfortunately, Windows will often assign Outlook Express as the default email client. Here’s how to configure Thunderbird as the default Windows email client.

1. Click on the “Tools” drop down menu and select “Options”.



2. In the “General” tab, place a checkmark as shown below.
3. Then click on the “Check Now” button.

4. Verify that your settings are as shown below.
5. Click “OK” (twice) to finish.
