

## Direct Links to Items in InfoSoup

You will still be able to provide direct links to catalog records from your web site, and it's going to be MUCH easier to do. Woo hoo!

### For links to specific items:

1. Perform a search in InfoSoup (my favorite is keyword = "bugs").
2. Click on the title you want to link to from your web site.
3. On the full record, you will see a "permanent link to this record" link under the item's book jacket. Click on that link.
4. The URL in your browser's address bar will change. Here's an example:  
<http://www.infosoup.org/record=b1567339>. Highlight the URL and copy it.
5. Paste in the new URL for your link on your web page.

### For links to subjects, authors or all versions of a title:

1. Perform a subject, author or title search.
2. From the resulting list, select the line number for the results you wish to see.

For example, an author search for "sandford, john" brings the following results:

3. Once you have a list like the one above, the URL in the address bar of your browser will change and you can highlight it, copy and paste it into your web page.

### For keyword searches:

1. Perform a keyword search.
2. Click on a title in the resulting list.
3. Click on the RETURN TO LIST button on the item full record.
4. When you return to the list, the URL in the address bar of your browser will change, and you can highlight it, copy and paste it into your web page.

NOTE: For subject, author, title, or keyword searches, you want a resulting link that looks like this:

**Not** this: <http://www.infosoup.org/search/a?a> or it won't work.
